COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

December 2018

The Committee continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct.¹ As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 12 requests for advisory opinions in December of 2018.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 115th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 23 new travel requests in December of 2018 for travel beginning in December or later. There were also 32 travelers who went on Committee approved, privately-sponsored, officially connected trips within the month of December.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in December of 2018. The Committee provided live training sessions attended by 187 individuals in December of 2018. The Committee also continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming in-person training sessions and online training opportunities is available on the Committee's website at <https://ethics.house.gov/>.

In December 2018, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for November 2018 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.

The Committee released four public statements in December 2018 regarding the matter of Representative Thomas Garrett, regarding Representative Rod Blum, regarding Representative Elizabeth Esty, and regarding Representative David Schweikert. Chairwoman Susan W. Brooks and Ranking Member Theodore E. Deutch released the public statements which are available on the Committee's Web site, at <https://ethics.house.gov/>.

The Committee released two general advisory reports in December of 2018 regarding Member Swearing-In Receptions and regarding a Reminder about Annual Ethics Training Requirements for 2018. Prior general advisories are available on the Committee's website at <https://ethics.house.gov/>.
