

"*Pershing County Economic Development and Conservation Act.*"

Wednesday, July 10, 2019---The Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands held a Legislative hearing on H.R. 1475, To create a publicly available lottery system for permits for the use of motorized or nonmotorized boats in the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness, and for other purposes. "*LOTTERY Act.*"

Wednesday, July 10, 2019---The Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands held a Legislative hearing on H.R. 2199, To designate certain Federal land in the State of California as wilderness, and for other purposes. "*Central Coast Heritage Protection Act.*"

Thursday, July 18, 2019---The Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife held a Legislative hearing on H.R. 2245, "*Conserving Ecosystems by Ceasing the Importation of Large Animal Trophies Act*" or "*CECIL Act*."

Thursday, July 25, 2019---The Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife held a Legislative hearing on H.R. 335, To require the Inter-Agency Task Force on Harmful Algal Blooms and Hypoxia to develop a plan for reducing, mitigating, and controlling harmful algal blooms and hypoxia in South Florida, and for other purposes, "*South Florida Clean Coastal Waters Act of 2019*."

Thursday, July 25, 2019---The Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife held a Legislative hearing on H.R. 729, To amend the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 to authorize grants to Indian Tribes to further achievement of Tribal coastal zone objectives, and for other purposes. "*Tribal Coastal Resiliency Act*."
